- Mooring Buoy, yachting buoy

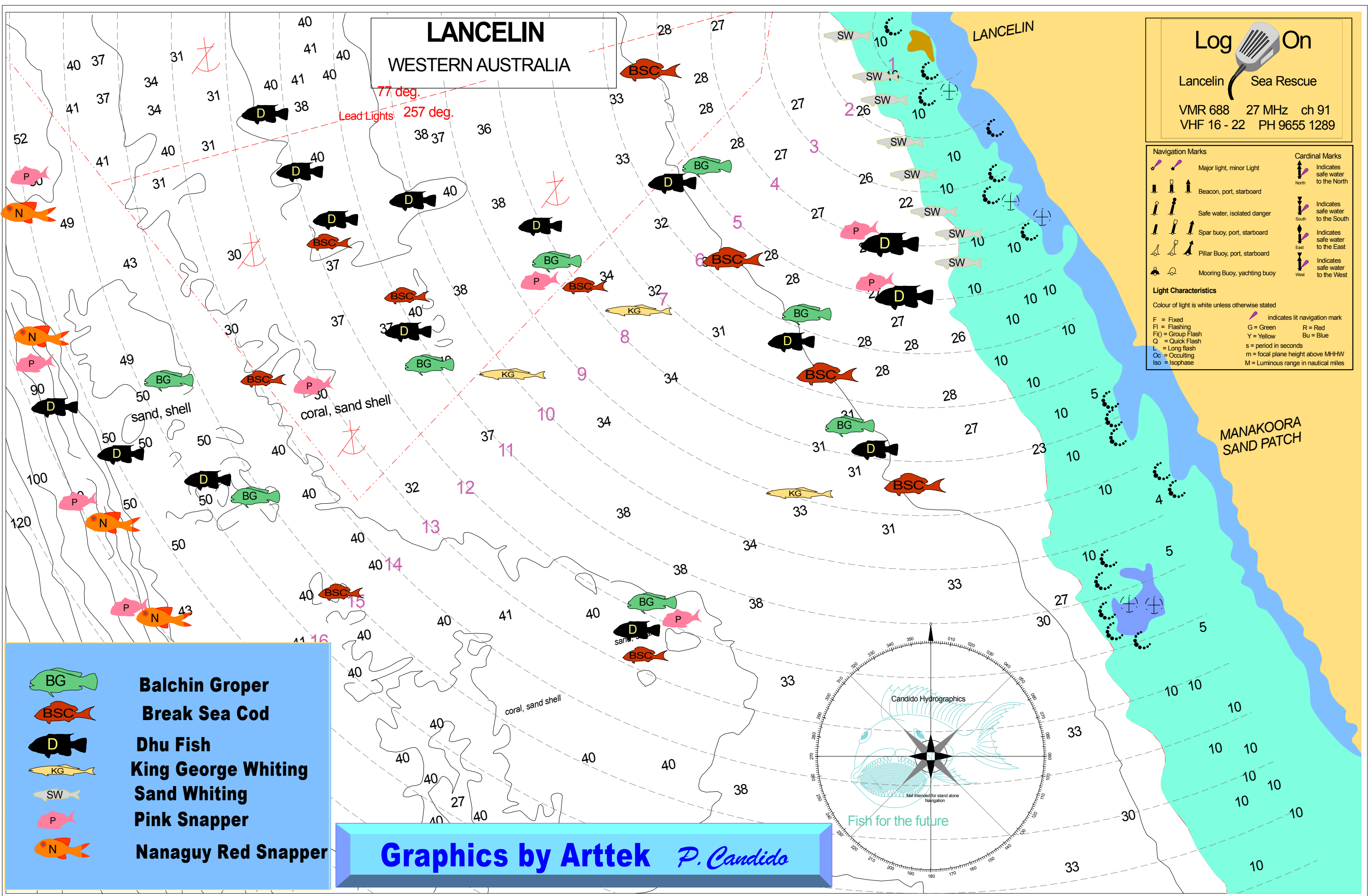
Cardinal Marks

- F = Fixed
- Fl = Flashing
- Fl() = Group Flash
- Q = Quick Flash
- L = Long flash
- Oc = Occulting
- Iso = Isophase
- indicates lit navigation mark
- G = Green
- Y = Yellow
- s = period in seconds
- m = focal plane height above MHHW
- M = Luminous range in nautical miles
- R = Red
- Bu = Blue
